MARINE CIRCULAR 15-004 GUIDANCE ON PORT STATE CONTROL INSPECTION AND COMPLIANCE CHECKLIST

COMPLIANCE CHECKLIST

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 Palau International Ship Registry, in its constant pursuit of continuous improvement has been reviewing the PSC performance of vessels registered with the Palau Flag after the first review it has been noted that detentions to Palau registered vessel is increasing which will result on the Flag being gray or black listed, position that we need to avoid by focusing on preventive actions that will allow the vessel to have a detention-free Port State Control Inspection. At the same, Palau Flag Administration is assured that by adhering to the preventive actions listed in this Marine Circular, the safety of the crew, vessels and the environment will also be ensured.
- 1.2 Available records show that most vessels are detained for any other of the following reasons:
- 1.2.1 Lifeboat davits and or release mechanism defective,
- 1.2.2 Emergency fire pump defective (does not draw water or insufficient pressure)
- 1.2.3 Emergency generator not working properly,
- 1.2.4 Logs and/or record books not maintained,
- 1.2.5 Communications equipment defective,
- 1.2.6 One or more officers did not have a Certificate of Endorsement
- 1.2.7 Nautical Charts and/or publications outdated,
- 1.2.8 Emergency lights/lighting defective,
- 1.2.9 Fire main leaking or defective,
- 1.2.10 No proof of fire-fighting or lifesaving equipment being serviced,
- 1.2.11 Various air pipe vents or flaps wasted or inoperative,
- 1.2.12 Rubber gaskets on vent pipe covers deteriorated,
- 1.2.13 Quick closing valves frozen or hard to operate,
- 1.2.14 Oil Water Separator and/or 15PPM alarm not functioning properly,
- 1.2.15 Closing devices for doors, access covers and hatch covers missing or defective,
- 1.2.16 Rubber gaskets for doors, access covers and//or hatch covers deteriorated
- 1.2.17 Repairs on deck completed without the notification and /or supervision of class,
- 1.2.18 Warbnings, notices and instructions that should be posted are missing,
- 1.2.19 Deck Machinery and or steering gear leaking hydraulic oil and
- 1.2.20 Sanitary and/or galley facilities inadequates

In order to take proactive actions towards upcoming and unannounced PSC Control Inspections, This Administration has developed the attached checklist which is to be completed before arrival of the vessel in port. The Checklist should be completed by the Master prior to departure of the vessel from port or during her voyage to next port.

During the process of completing the Checklist if the Master notices a deficiency that may be a cause for detention, the Master is to notify the Recognized Organization and the Flag Administration. As per *IMO Resolution 1052(27) provision 2.3.7* states that if a Master advises his Administration, Class and Local Port State Authorities of a deficiency that has, or may, impact the vessel's seaworthiness, that deficiency should not be considered as grounds for detention, unless the ship intends to sail with the deficiency un-addressed.

In the case that a defective device or equipment is noted or a problem with the vessel's Certificates including Flag, Statutory or Crew arise, this Administration should be contacted immediately. PISR will work with the Owner, Managers, Operators and Recognized Organization in many possible ways in order to prevent a detention.

The attached checklist is be used to inspect the ship thoroughly as part of the on board preparation prior to PSC Visits.

In addition if a required equipment on board is not operating properly or is defective, the vessel operator or Master should contact the Administration and request a dispensation. If the malfunctions happens while the vessel is at sea and before the vessel's arrival in port issuance of a dispensation may prevent a PSC detention.
