MARINE NOTICE 12-005 RADIO ACCOUNTING AUTHORITES

To: ALL SHIPOWNERS, MANAGERS, MASTERS AND OFFICERS OF SHIPS FLYING UNDER THE PALAU FLAG

Subject: GUIDELINES FOR COMPLIANCE WITH RADIO ACCOUNTING AUTHORITY

1. Purpose

- 1.1 The purpose of this Marine Notice is to explain and guide the shipowner, manager, operators, Master and Officers of vessels flying the Palau Flag of the radio accounting procedures required by the Palau International Ship Registry.
- 1.2 This Notice also provides a list of the Accounting Authorities approved by the Maritime Administrator on behalf of the Palau International Ship Registry.

2. Applicability

- 2.1 This Marine Notice applies to all Palau Flag vessels equipped with ship radio stations.

3. Requirements

- 3.1 The International Telecommunication Union (ITU) Convention currently in force provides for Radio Accounting Authorities to settle maritime radio communications accounts for ships licensed by The Republic of Palau.
- 3.2 It is mandatory that all international maritime radio traffic charges for radio communication from ship to shore, both terrestrial and satellite, shall be settle by an approved Radio Accounting Authority which has legal contract with the owner of the vessel.

- 3.3 All ships in the process of being registered with the Palau Flag or are to maintain registration under the Palau Flag shall have entered into a valid contract with an Radio Accounting Authority. Confirmation of such contract should be sent to the Palau International Ship Registry. The Confirmation can be sent directly by the Radio Accounting Authority or by the shipowner or operator provided that the Confirmation is written by the Radio Accounting Authority.
- 3.4 All ships that are registered with the Palau Flag and which to change ownership or change Radio Accounting Authorities should present to the Palau International Ship Registry confirmation of Radio Accounting Authority contract as mentioned in section 3.3.

4. Approval of Radio Accounting Authority

- 4.1 Radio Accounting Authorities are approved only by the Maritime Administrator on behalf of the Palau International Ship Registry.
