Subject: Requirements for the issuance of Exemption Certificates

Reference: SOLAS 1974, Regulation I/12; 1988 SOLAS Protocol, Regulation I/12 MARPOL 73/78 Annex I Regulation 3; Annex II Regulation 4; Annex VI Regulation 3 LL Convention Article 6; 1988 LL Protocol Article 6 IMO Resolution MSC.122(75) for specific exemptions in the IMDG Code IMO SLS.14/Circ.115 Add.1, Add.2 and Add.3

Purpose

To inform all interested parties on the requirements and procedures for the issuance of an Exemption Certificate for Sierra Leonean vessels.

Application

- 1. This Circular applies to all Sierra Leonean vessels.
- A request for an exemption to be granted to a vessel in accordance with the provisions of an International Convention / Code must be submitted to SLMARAD by the Recognized Organization.
- **3.** The request must include the following:
 - SLMARAD Application Form "AFE01" properly filled out
 - Copy of the relevant statutory certificate and its attached forms and/or supplements.

- 4. SLMARAD will review the request and may grant exemptions from the provisions of an International Convention / Code if the vessel complies with the conditions established by such Conventions / Codes for the specific exemption.
- Upon reviewing the application, SLMARAD will authorize the Recognized Organization to issue the Exemption Certificate by submitting an authorization number. The authorization number must be visible on the Exemption Certificate.
- **6.** In case the request for an exemption is rejected, SLMARAD will inform the Recognized Organization on the grounds of such rejection.
- 7. The validity of the Exemption Certificate must be identical to the relevant statutory certificate, unless SLMARAD advices otherwise.
- Copy of the issued Exemption Certificate must be submitted by the Recognized Organization to SLMARAD within three (3) working days upon the date of issuance.
- 9. The fee for the issuance of an Exemption Certificate is 280 USD
- 10. In special circumstances SLMARAD may issue directly an Exemption Certificate after receiving a request from the Recognized Organization. The Recognized Organization must submit the documents specified in paragraph 3.
- 11. SLMARAD will authorize Recognized Organizations to renew previous Exemption Certificates after the documents specified in paragraph 3 are submitted collectively with the previous Exemption Certificate.
- **12.** Recognized Organizations cannot issue or renew an Exemption Certificate prior SLMARAD's approval.
